

High-Level Event of the General Assembly *The Contributions of Women, the Young and Civil Society to the Post-2015 Development Agenda*, 6-7 of March, 2014

Issues to be addressed

The high-level event will address key issues, such as:

- How can the Post-2015 Development Agenda address the diverse and intersecting inequalities that challenge inclusive sustainable development prospects on the basis of income, gender, age, race/ethnicity and disabilities, among other factors of marginalization?
- What measures must be taken and what accountability and transparency mechanisms should be established to ensure that women, young people and civil society are given the space to actively and meaningfully engage in shaping, implementing and monitoring the Post-2015 Development Agenda at all levels?
- How do Member States envision that the rights and needs of all women and young people will be reflected in the Post-2015 Development Agenda?
- How can the UN system better support efforts at the national, regional and global levels towards reducing inequality and discrimination?
- Can meaningful metrics (goals and/or targets) be devised to ensure that women and young people are not left behind in the implementation of the Post-2015 Development Agenda at all levels?
